## "14. WITHDRAWAL TO ANOTHER DENOMINATION OR SURRENDER OF CREDENTIALS

Retired clergy who withdraw to another denomination or surrender their credentials will no longer be eligible for the Conference funding through the health reimbursement account at Via Benefits. Loss of funding occurs on the date of withdrawal or surrendering of credentials. The participant will have six months from that date to claim reimbursement for expenses incurred prior to the date of withdrawal or surrendering credentials. The same applies for any non-clergy spouse of a retired clergy withdrawing to another denomination or surrendering credentials. No additional funding will be made available."
