- Complete the Adult Application, MinistrySafe Training and Background Check
- Familiarize yourself with and abide by the NTC MinistrySafe Policy
- Attend all CCYM meetings (find a replacement if you are unable to attend)
- Assist CCYM youth from your district in securing transportation to CCYM meetings
- Support CCYM Youth in THEIR vision for youth ministry
- Assist with leadership and attend CCYM sponsored events
- Recruit CCYM members
- Stay in touch and regularly communicate with Conference Staff and other CCYM members. CHECK AND ANSWER YOUR EMAIL, RETURN PHONE CALLS, ETC!!!
- Support your district by attending events and meetings
- Lead and pray with youth, small groups and other adults
- Pray regularly for your local church, CCYM, NTC and the global church
