Salary

Total Cash Salary provided by the local church <u>before</u> any reductions are made.

Cash Salary is Total Cash Salary less any amount the clergy elects to move into housing exclusion, if applicable. This amount is <u>auto-calculated</u>.

Salary Support – Equitable compensation, New Church Start, or other annual conference funds/grants/subsidies

Total Base Compensation = Cash Salary + Salary Support

Housing

Housing Allowance – Funds paid by the local church in lieu of providing a parsonage. Housing allowance is only available if the clergy does not live in a parsonage.

Housing Exclusion – A clergy determined amount of cash salary provided by the local church that the clergy wishes to <u>reclassify</u> as non-taxable housing.

Parsonage Utilities – Utilities paid directly by the local church, only available if the clergy is living in a parsonage.

Total Housing = Housing Allowance + Housing Exclusion + Parsonage Utilities

Pension Plan Compensation (PPC)

PPC (no parsonage) = Total Base Compensation + Total Housing

PPC (with a parsonage) = Total Base Compensation + (Total Housing x 1.35)

Pension Plan Personal Contributions

Compass (Full, ¾, ½)

- PPC x 4% is the minimum Compass personal contribution for the full match by the local church
- Contributions may be made by <u>percentage of PPC</u> before tax, after-tax, after-tax Roth

UMPIP (1/4)

- There is only a personal contribution no match made by the local church
- Contributions may be made by <u>dollars or percentage of PPC</u> before tax, after-tax, after-tax Roth

Compass Required Benefits (Full Time, ¾, ½)

- Compass Annual Flat Contribution (based on percentage of appointment)
- Compass Annual Non-Matching Contribution (3% of PPC)
- Compass Annual Matching Contribution (4% of PPC)
