## Jahweh Rafah became the 1st UMC church in Balch Springs in over a 100 years

Jahweh Rafah is a Hispanic ministry that has impacted the lives of hundreds of people around the cities of Rowlett, Garland, Rockwall. Irving, Forney, Arlington, Kaufman, Cedar Hill, and Dallas. The Hispanic congregation was originally placed in First Rowlett UMC on November 3, 2013.

The congregation has been defined as a cultural dynamic and language diversity church. Jahweh Rafah is moved to Balch Spring in a mostly Spanish speaking community where up to 55.1% of the population are Hispanics. As pastor Georginnette Haddock expressed: "We have never doubted that the Holy Spirit has been guiding our calling as a church and ministry leading us to the perfect place to spread the gospel of Grace. At our opening, people from the community have constantly approached the church confirming the hunger for God they experience. We pray to God to allow us to be the ministry of Jesus visible in the community that in 100 years of history had not had a Church of Wesleyan theology in its surroundings."
