#### Doctor of Ministry 6 semesters

#### Master of Ministry 36 credit hours (12 courses)

Gain a theological and spiritual foundation for ministry leadership.

#### Master of Arts 36 credit hours (12 courses)

Earn a degree while completing The UMC's Advanced Course of Study, or design a curriculum that supports your call.

#### Master of Divinity 78 credit hours (26 courses)

Prepare for ordained ministry or leadership as a lay professional with practical, spiritual and academic training.

#### Master of Arts in Christian Ministries 45 credit hours (15 courses)

Experience strong faith-based learning that equips you for service to Church and community.

### Master of Theological Studies 48 credit hours (16 courses)
